- A permanent resident of New Zealand, or
- A citizen or permanent resident of Australia residing in New Zealand

### All *new* students must provide evidence of citizenship or permanent residency and to do so you must produce one of the following:

- Birth certificate with place of birth stated as New Zealand, Cook Islands, Tokelau, or Niue
- An assertion through RealMe® that you were born in New Zealand (prior to 2005)
- New Zealand passport
- A statement of whakapapa, including date of birth, countersigned by a kaumatua
- Certificate of citizenship or letter of confirmation
- Overseas passport with residency stamp
- Australian students who are living in New Zealand must supply one of the following documents: birth certificate, Australian passport, or a current Returning Resident's Visa if you are an Australian permanent resident

You can bring the original documentation to the Admissions office, alternatively please provide a verified copy. This means a photocopy of your original document, signed as being a true and accurate copy by a Justice of the Peace (JP), Barrister or Solicitor, Notary Public, Court Registrar or Deputy Registrar, Member of Parliament, Land Transport New Zealand, Public Trust, or local authority employee designated for this purpose. When a learner is in a remote community and unable to access a person listed in the Oaths and Declarations Act, please ask Admissions for advice.

- □ Name change If your name on your form of ID differs from the name you have now, please provide documentation of the change e.g. a marriage certificate, deed poll or other proof of name change. This must be the original or a verified copy (see above). Scanned and emailed copies are not acceptable.
- □ **One more document,** not more than 3 months old, that helps to verify who you are and where you live, e.g. a power or phone bill, a bank statement or letter to you with your name and address printed on it. Scanned and emailed copies are not acceptable.
