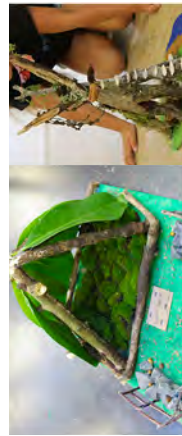

Friday 18th | 9.30am-12.30pm

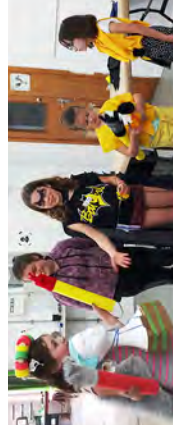
