Protocol	According to TLC protocol, any student has the right to request that music be turned off or changed.
Procedures	Music played on TLC Premises is a matter of general consent and anyone present has the right of 'veto', that is, the right to require that the music be changed, turned down or turned off.  Unless,  The music is specifically related to the substance of the class and necessary for what is being taught. In this case, should a student find the music to be offensive in any way (too loud, too harsh, etc.) then that student is free to leave the class for that part
	of the session. The tutor leading the session must be informed.
