Policy detail	<p>The Play Fund is for activities that support students to develop a sense of community and relationship between themselves and the school.</p> <p>The Play Fund is \$100 per term and can accumulate over a calendar year, before defaulting back to zero on the last day of December.</p> <p>HOW TO APPLY:</p> <p>The Play Fund can be accessed by a proposal from the student representative, made directly to the Management group.</p> <p>GUIDELINES:</p> <p>Proposals are open to on-site and off-site students.</p> <p>Proposals should contain a clear outline of what you want to do, how you want to do it and what you will spend money on. It is also good to detail other initiatives being undertaken by students to support the event.</p> <p>Money should be used to cover costs that students may not otherwise be able to afford and which will mean that the event is able to happen. Wages or alcohol cannot be approved as an expense.</p> <p>Proposals should explain how the activity/project will develop a sense of community and, relationships between groups of students and the school and, how many students will be able to be involved in the project/activity.</p> <p>Projects that benefit larger numbers of students will be preferred.</p> <p>The types of proposals that we will consider include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contributing to shared lunches • Orientation week initiatives for students to meet and greet each other • Morning/afternoon teas to celebrate student successes • Guest speakers • Art materials swaps, prizes for specific group projects • Events for off-site students to meet socially <p>Decisions will be made on a case by case basis at the discretion of the Academic Board.</p>
