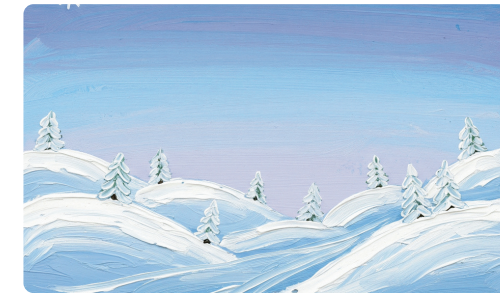
WEDNESDAY

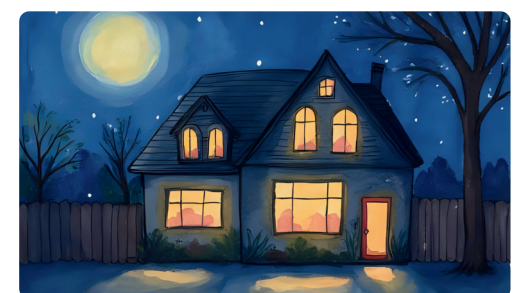
SOUTHERN LIGHTS
